

## Workshop venue

### WTC Schiphol Business & Conference Centre, Room G3.08

Go to Schiphol plaza (where the train station is). Take the escalator (direction WTC/Sheraton/Hilton) to a covered walkway. Continue past the Sheraton until you see the entrance of the WTC on your left. You take the escalator, turn left and then right into a corridor. Continue until you see the WTC business & conference centre on your left.

## Workshop Objectives

C-ITS deployment is underway and initially progressed in corridor projects and pilots all over Europe. The Amsterdam Group and the CODECS partners aim on harmonising the ongoing activities in these various deployment hot spots. They have jointly set up a series of public workshops to discuss their work with other stakeholders and interested organisations. After the premier of the „C-ITS Deployment is underway!“ workshops in September 2015 in Roskilde in Denmark, this second edition provides corridor initiatives and pilots with a platform to report their progress in making cooperative road traffic a reality. They will give a status update with regard to lessons-learned, identified deployment challenges as well as selected solutions approaches, and discuss open deployment issues.

### CODECS

CODECS (COoperative ITS DEployment Coordination Support) acts as nodal point pooling the interests of stakeholders involved in the consecutive C-ITS implementation phases. It builds up a stakeholder network and, through interactive discussion in workshops, webinars and personal interviews, CODECS-partners identify functional approaches, roles & responsibilities, preferred use cases and requirements for strategic decision making. Out of the consolidated stakeholder needs and priorities, it develops guidelines for initial deployment as well as testing, specification and standardisation in later innovation phases.
